



CP Theatre 2020 Health and Safety Protocols

General Protocols

Anyone with a fever of over 100.0 or other COVID-like symptoms will not be permitted at CP Theatre class or rehearsal until they are symptom and fever-free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

CP Theatre will encourage our students and staff to follow the most current local and state government mandates regarding face masks. Students should wear face coverings but will not be required to do so to participate.

CP Theatre will honor any requests from class or rehearsal venues regarding face masks and all will be expected to comply.

Enforcement of hand and respiratory hygiene including coughing/sneezing etiquette and hand washing.

Frequent disinfection of facilities.

Incorporate social distancing between groups/classes as much as possible.

All students, staff and volunteers must sign the COVID-19 Release form and agree not to attend a CP Theatre function if any of the following are true:

- Have had a fever in the last 72 hours
- Have experienced any unusual respiratory distress including cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell, or chills, vomiting or diarrhea in the past 72 hours.
- Have been in physical contact with anyone with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 or traveled to any location on the State's "must quarantine list" in the past 14 days.
